

## **Florin Georgescu, Professor, Ph.D.**

### Short Latest Biographical Statement



Professor Florin Georgescu has held the position of Vice Chairman of the Board and First Deputy Governor of the National Bank of Romania since 2004. He also served as Deputy – Prime Minister and Minister of Public Finance between November 1992 - December 1996, as well as between May - December 2012, being the longest-serving minister of this portfolio in the past 25 years in Romania. Between December 1996 and April 2004, Mr. Florin Georgescu fulfilled two mandates in the Parliament. Shortly after (April-October 2004), he became the Chairmen of the Supervisory Board of Banca Comercială Română (BCR), the largest bank in Romania. In the academic area, he is the author, co-author and coordinator of numerous books and scientific papers. He graduated from the Faculty of Finance and Accounting, within the Bucharest University of Economic Studies, he got a PhD in economics and was awarded the Doctor Honoris Causa degree by six Romanian universities. In addition, his educational background includes Fulbright Alexander Hamilton Fellow as visiting scholar of University of Missouri Kansas City, USA, in 1991-1992 academic year.
